ISSUE:

FY22 One-Time Hazard Pay Bonus for Sworn Sheriffs, Sheriffs' Deputies & Regional Jail Officers

BACKGROUND:

The budget adopted by the Virginia General Assembly included funding for the State Compensation Board to provide a one-time hazard pay bonus of \$3,000 for state-supported sworn officers of Sheriff's Departments and Regional Jails. The bonus payments are being provided in response to the impacts of the ongoing coronavirus pandemic on Sheriff's Offices throughout the Commonwealth.

ISSUE:

Discussion of Public Hearing for Riverside Health System's Application for a Certificate of Public Need
